- 1) *Welcome and self- introductions of any new members to Golden Gate Section as well as all members, fee-payers, retired members, and guests ;*
- 2) *Use of state equipment, especially computers - Be aware!!*
- 3) *Stay tuned for PECG's support for upcoming elections - but no Mayor Reed pension measure!*
 - a. *Mayor Reed's pension measure was too late to qualify for 2014 elections and now it's dead until 2018*
- 4) *PECG's position that as much safety oversight as possible, especially when costs do not justify otherwise, be performed by state engineers;*
 - a. *PECG recently involved with an issue concerning the outsourcing of elevator inspections at SFO.*
 - b. *Outsourcing intentions at the CPUC*
- 5) *Use of personal vehicles and telecommuting*
 - a. *Reminder that MOU does not mandate employees to use vehicles or telecommute ;*
 - b. *Reminder for members to check the latest PECG Unit 9 MOU that contains modified travel reimbursement amounts (including Sacramento).*
- 6) *Clarify that the employer cannot voluntarily reduce an employee's hours in order to reduce overtime hours;*
 - a. *What about agreements between an employee and the supervisor*
- 7) *Employee morale concerns at the CPUC*
 - a. *Do recent CPUC survey results truly reflect employee concerns and beliefs?*
 - b. *Many members have expressed concerns that non-engineer supervisors are, systematically, negatively targeting engineers (need specifics);*
 - c. *Is there continuing intent on the part of the CPUC to stray away from work that is of technical nature, difficult to perform, time resource intensive, but crucial to the agency's function;*
- 8) *A request submitted on March 7th to meet with CPUC Executive Director Tim Sullivan - thus far, no response*
- 9) *Status of pay raises for rank and file & supervisors;*
 - a. *Five percent pay raise for rank & file starting July 1 still on track. Funds budgeted for supervisors, as well.*
 - b. *It is important that we keep things under hat and NOT complain or gloat!!*
- 10) *Issues of concern to Section members / Q&A*
